



**AGREEMENT OF CO-OPERATION**  
**BETWEEN**  
**HELLENIC INSTITUTE OF MARINE TECHNOLOGY (HIMT)**  
**AND**  
**SNAME GREEK SECTION**

By this agreement, the Hellenic Institute of Marine Technology (HIMT) and the SNAME Greek Section confirm their co-operative relationship in the areas of mutual interest devoted to the promotion of the art and science of naval architecture and maritime technology. The specific terms of this agreement are as follows:

- Members of HIMT and SNAME Greek Section may attend conferences, seminars, training courses and other events organized by the other Society on the same financial basis as members of the other Society at local level.
- All publications other than journals will be made available to members of the other Society, at the same cost as to members of the other Society as long as they are ordered by the SNAME Europe office.
- Copies of each Society's journals will be supplied regularly to the other Society's libraries. In case one of the involved parties does not publish journals then such a supply is not mandatory.
- Each Society will publish details of the other Society's activities, in its journals, Newsletters, etc., sharing articles where appropriate.
- Each Society will encourage its members to submit papers for presentation at conferences, seminars and technical meetings, or publication in technical journals of the other Society.
- Each Society will explore ways to encourage its technical groups to involve the appropriate groups of the other Society in their activities.

- Both Societies will explore ways in which they can co-operate together with other Societies of like aims and objectives in the organizing of conferences and seminars.
- Both Societies will endeavor to promote the concept of creating a Federation of marine societies that will present one voice and provide significant positive influence in the area of international maritime safety, environment and ship operation.

This agreement shall become effective after it has been approved by the governing bodies of HIMT and SNAME Greek Section, and signed by their duly authorized officers.

The terms of this agreement may be amplified, but not changed, in correspondence between the General Secretary of HIMT and the SNAME Greek Section Executive Committee. Changes to the terms of the agreement may be proposed at any time, and will be valid after the approval of the governing bodies.

This agreement shall be effective for a period of five years. At that time, the Agreement will be re-confirmed by the governing bodies, and re-issued under the signature of the then current Chairman of HIMT and SNAME Greek Section Chairman.
